

Kenya Bans Plastic Bags with Immediate Effect



Dear Valued Travel Partner

The Kenyan Government announced that from 28th August 2017, Plastic bags are now banned in Kenya.

Please ensure all travelers with plans of visiting Kenya are aware of this ban. Being in possession of a plastic bag will be considered a violation of the law and will be penalized accordingly.

Travelers are urged to avoid packing plastic bags in suitcases or in carry-on luggage as the Kenya National Environmental and Management Authority advised one will be required to remove all plastic bags before entering Kenya. This will include duty-free plastic shopping bags.

We strongly advise all travelers to check hand luggage before disembarking in Nairobi and to leave any plastic bags on the aircraft.
